

Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA) Policy

Last Updated: February 16, 2025

1. Introduction

Aequitas Invest (“Company,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) respects the intellectual property rights of others and expects users of our website, platform, and services (the “Platform”) to do the same.

In accordance with the Digital Millennium Copyright Act of 1998 (“DMCA”), we respond promptly to valid notices of alleged copyright infringement and take appropriate action as required by law, including removal or disabling access to allegedly infringing material.

This policy outlines our procedures for submitting copyright infringement notifications and counter-notifications.

2. Designated DMCA Agent

We have designated the following agent to receive notifications of claimed copyright infringement:

3. Filing a DMCA Takedown Notice

If you believe that content hosted on our Platform infringes your copyright, you may submit a written notification containing the following information (as required by 17 U.S.C. §512(c)(3)):

1. A physical or electronic signature of the copyright owner or authorized representative
2. Identification of the copyrighted work claimed to have been infringed
3. Identification of the allegedly infringing material and its location (URL or specific description)
4. Your name, address, telephone number, and email address

5. A statement that you have a good faith belief that the use is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law
6. A statement that the information in the notice is accurate, and under penalty of perjury, that you are authorized to act on behalf of the copyright owner

Notices that fail to comply with these requirements may be deemed invalid.

4. Takedown Procedure

Upon receipt of a valid DMCA notice, we will:

- Review the notice for completeness
- Remove or disable access to the allegedly infringing material
- Notify the content uploader of the removal
- Provide information regarding counter-notification rights

We reserve the right to remove content at our discretion where infringement risk is evident.

5. Counter-Notification Process

If you believe your content was removed in error or misidentification, you may submit a counter-notification including:

1. Your physical or electronic signature
2. Identification of the material removed and its prior location
3. A statement under penalty of perjury that you have a good faith belief the material was removed by mistake or misidentification
4. Your name, address, phone number, and email
5. A statement consenting to jurisdiction of the Federal District Court in your district (or where the service provider is located)
6. A statement that you will accept service of process from the person who provided the original notification (or an agent of such person).

Counter-notices must be sent to our designated DMCA Agent.

6. Content Restoration

If we receive a valid counter-notification:

- We will provide a copy to the original complainant
- We will restore the content within 10–14 business days unless the complainant notifies us that they have filed a court action seeking to restrain the alleged infringement

7. Repeat Infringer Policy

In accordance with the DMCA and other applicable laws, we maintain a policy for terminating, in appropriate circumstances, users who are deemed repeat infringers. This DMCA Policy applies to copyright claims only. For trademark, defamation, privacy, or other legal complaints, please contact us at contact@aequitasinvest.com with 'Legal Request' in the subject line.

Actions may include:

- Content removal
- Account suspension
- Permanent account termination

We reserve the right to limit platform access for users who repeatedly upload infringing material.

Also, we will reasonably implement this policy and accommodate and not interfere with standard technical measures, as defined in 17 U.S.C. §512(i)

8. Misrepresentation

Any person who knowingly misrepresents that material is infringing — or that it was removed by mistake — may be subject to liability under 17 U.S.C. §512(f).

We reserve the right to pursue damages where false claims are made in bad faith.

9. Scope of Policy

This DMCA Policy applies to all user-generated and third-party content on our Platform, including but not limited to:

- Issuer materials
- Offering pages
- Videos and podcasts
- Images and graphics
- Marketing materials
- Blog posts and comments
